The International Consortium on Governmental Financial Management is unique in the financial management community. It was established in 1977 by a distinguished and international group of financial management professionals from government and academia. They recognized the need for the various financial practitioners to engage in dialogue about their perspectives for improving government financial management. ICGFM became the first “umbrella” organization composed of government entities, university departments, private firms, and professional associations devoted to improving financial management.

ICGFM reached out to those in the broad array of financial management disciplines. Today the membership includes accountants, auditors, comptrollers, treasurers, budgeters, information technologists, policy makers, and others who share our mission.

OUR MISSION

“Working globally with governments, organizations and individuals, the International Consortium on Governmental Financial Management is dedicated to improving financial management so that governments may better serve their citizens”

Our mission emphasizes our international focus. Increasingly the financial community is a global one and we recognize this in our activities, publications, and programs.

OUR PROGRAMS

We support our members and others by promoting and supporting professional development activities and information exchange that advance effective governmental financial management principles, standards, and practices. While we support research and incorporate research findings, our emphasis is on assisting the practitioners. We sponsor meetings, forums, and conferences that bring together government financial managers from around the world to learn new and innovative approaches to emerging challenges, including promoting good governance, transparency, accountability, and combating fraud and corruption .



MEMBERSHIP

As a member, you can showcase and communicate your projects globally through ICGFM programs, publications and support. Our current members include private and public organizations at all levels, including national audit offices/supreme audit institutions, finance ministries/treasury departments, regional and international development banks, professional associations, donor organizations, private sector firms, and individuals.

There are three levels of membership.

SUSTAINING MEMBERS: Sustaining members are organizations who have a major stake in improving governmental financial management through financial and/or technical assistance. These members actively participate in determining the direction and activities of the Consortium through a seat on the Board of Directors and participation in other leadership positions. These organizations receive reduced meeting and conference fees for up to 20 members of their organization, and up to 20 complimentary hardcopies of ICGFM publications. (Dues are \$1,000 annually).

ORGANIZATION MEMBERS: Organization members include public and private organizations committed to working with others in the professional community to leverage learning and networking activities through the work of our “umbrella” organization. Six organization level members sit on the Board of Directors. Organization-level members

also receive reduced meeting and conference fees for up to five members of their organization, and up to 5 complimentary hardcopies of ICGFM publications. (Dues are \$250/\$150* annually.)

INDIVIDUAL MEMBERS: Individual members are persons interested in or dedicated to financial management activities who wish to be members in their own right. Six individual members sit on the Board of Directors. Individual members receive reduced registration for meetings and conferences and a hardcopy of all ICGFM publications. (Dues are \$100/\$50* annually.)

* Special discounts are offered to developing countries, countries with economies in transition, and regional groups, organizations, and individuals in such countries.
